NAIROBI IS THE CAPITAL AND LARGEST CITY OF KENYA, LOCATED IN THE SOUTHERN PART OF THE COUNTRY.

: SITUATED IN THE HIGHLANDS AT AN ELEVATION OF ABOUT 1,795 METERS (5,889 FEET) ABOVE SEA LEVEL, NAIROBI ENJOYS A TEMPERATE CLIMATE COMPARED TO MANY OTHER PARTS OF THE COUNTRY.

1. ECONOMIC HUB: NAIROBI IS THE ECONOMIC HUB OF KENYA, SERVING AS A MAJOR CENTER FOR FINANCE, COMMERCE, AND INDUSTRY. IT HOSTS THE NAIROBI SECURITIES EXCHANGE (NSE), THE LARGEST STOCK EXCHANGE IN EAST AND CENTRAL AFRICA.
